

The Association of Carolina Shag Clubs (ACSC) held their spring business meeting on Saturday April 27th at the Spanish Galleon. LNSC was represented by myself, John Stewart and Pat Hensley. The ACSC and SOS Board members provided business updates including financial information and SOS card sales. There were a couple of key topics communicated to the shag club representatives. No shag club has volunteered to host the Summer Workshop in 2024. Therefore, the workshop will be held during the Fall Migration. This decision is just for 2024 and will be revisited for 2025. LNSC has hosted this event in the past and we understand the work effort and financial impact a club may experience. Hopefully there will be a club with the resources necessary to host this event in 2025.

Another key topic presented was announcing a price increase for SOS cards in 2025. An increase of \$10 will be in place next year, \$45 with a \$5 discount when purchased through a shag club. Cost increases and a decline in cards sales were main reasons for the increase.

Fun Monday tickets were distributed to the clubs. It was emphasized the need to sell tickets as the profits fund the donations to various charitable organizations. The top prize this year has been raised to \$5,000. I will share more information at our May meeting.

The 2024 ACSC Shagging ICON awards were also presented during the meeting. The recipients were Tom Cullum from Augusta GA, Hilda Bowen (posthumously) from Florence SC, Dina Delevie from Charlotte NC, Marsha Ruth from Portsmouth VA and Georgia Vaughn from Spartanburg SC. We are still working to schedule dance lessons prior to our meeting each month. We will communicate more as we get a schedule finalized.
