Editor's Letter

The Importance of Perspective: A Lesson from *Wicked*

Hello LNSC Family. I hope everyone is doing well and getting prepared for the Holiday Season. I pray you all had a great Thanksgiving as well. We enjoyed thanksgiving with family, but I think the highlight of my holiday was getting to see *Wicked* (the movie). I have loved *Wicked* since reading the book. I have also seen it on Broadway. The movie was very well done, and I feel like there are some important takeaways that I'd like to share.

The Broadway sensation *Wicked* challenges audiences to reconsider the boundaries between good and evil, offering a poignant lesson about perspective. By retelling *The Wizard of Oz* through the eyes of Elphaba, the so-called Wicked Witch of the West, the story dismantles black-and-white narratives to reveal the complexities of morality.

One of the most powerful lessons from *Wicked* is the importance of understanding another's point of view. Elphaba, initially perceived as a villain, is shown to be a misunderstood character driven by compassion and a fierce sense of justice. Her green skin and unconventional beliefs make her an outcast, yet her intentions are noble. In contrast, Glinda, the seemingly perfect Good Witch, struggles with vanity and self-interest despite her benevolent title. This duality emphasizes that labels like "good" and "wicked" often depend on who tells the story.

Wicked teaches us that assumptions about others can be misleading. The narrative encourages empathy and critical thinking, urging us to question how societal norms and biases shape our judgments. By exploring Elphaba's side of the story, we learn that understanding someone's struggles and motivations can completely transform our perception of them.

In a world often quick to judge, *Wicked* reminds us to seek deeper truths, celebrate differences, and approach others with compassion. Its timeless lesson resonates far beyond the theater, inspiring us to see the world—and each other—through more empathetic eyes.

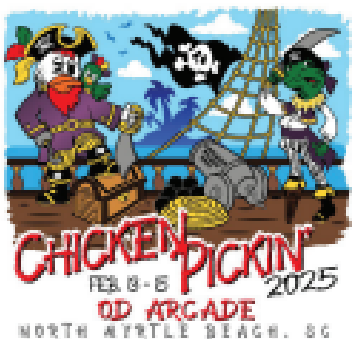
