A Special message from Tyler Barkley (Grandson of Terry & Carolyn Hopper) that he posted on Facebook May 30th of this year & I thought it worth sharing with you.

"Just wanted to say something.. Here it goes:

Six months and eight days ago my life changed completely. Brantly Evans and I were hunting the first evening of rifle season. We were headed to the other side of the farm where we hunt and I wasn't paying attention and ran off the road. I over-corrected and flipped my truck four times over 200 feet. The worse part was I wasn't wearing a seatbelt. I was thrown out of the truck. The end result was me breaking my collarbone, two skull fractures, and three brain hemorages. I had to airlifted to Baptist. So many people stayed by my side, crying and praying the whole side but there were also those people who weren't by my side physically yet they were mentally and spiritually that helped so much more. In total I was in the hospital 17 days. My mom didn't leave my side once, sleeping on a couch in my room and on a recliner that folded out to the most uncomfortable bed ever. I pulled through a lot better and quicker anyone would have thought. I admit it, me and Brantly talk about it a lot. How lucky and blessed we both were. The Lord was with us that day, I owe it all to Him. I just wanted to say thank you to everyone for their support for me during this whole situation. It's taught me a lot. To trust in The Lord because he controls all, He is all knowing, and He protects His children. Never, ever take life for granted because it can change so quickly. I've learned a lot and taken a lot in these past 6 months. I got a beautiful girlfriend that's been right by my side the entire time, even when I'm moody, in trouble, or just being "emotional" I guess you could say. I've had an amazing family, parents, and an awesome little brother, Cole Barkley by my side supporting me every day even when I'm irritated at them and just frustrated with the whole world. I wouldn't want to have any other family at all because I believe I have the best out there. I've completed AP Physics, got inducted to the Beta Club, and a Junior Marshal for my school. I was determined and worked hard to be where I'm at, the wreck HAS NOT changed that. If anything it has made me work harder for anything and everything. But the last thing I wanted to say was I drove by myself for the first time today. As you can imagine it was nerve-racking and made me extremely nervous, so before I went home I just stopped and prayed, "Lord give me the strength to do this, to drive good, not make bad choices and just be calm and collective as well as safe." He got me home safe, I got myself home safe. In the end I just want to say is don't take life for granted. Live slow and think about the consequences of things before you do them."

Thank you Tyler for being such an inspiration to so many people! Please share this with your children & grandchildren, it's a message worth passing along!


